## Hiking Trails in the Dells Area

Devil's Lake State Park is about 15 miles from the Dells and offers some of the best hiking trails in the Midwest. Even folks who don't get out much can usually manage the East and West bluff trails that provide the most scenic views of the lake. Experienced hikers looking for longer hikes and less people can explore the Steinke Basin, Uplands & Ice Age trails all located east of the lake itself. The Uplands & Ice Age trails are about as close to wilderness hiking you'll find in the area but are still nicely maintained. Devil's Lake also has paved wheelchair accessible trails.

Mirror Lake & Rocky Arbor State Parks are right in Wisconsin Dells (well almost) and offer some nice trails. Generally the trails are wooded and accessible to hikers of all experience levels. There are more than 19 miles of hiking trails at Mirror Lake State Park.
